Getting to Ballard School

The school is located half a mile north of New Milton town centre on the B3058. Entry to the school grounds is by way of an entrance only private drive which feeds into a one-way system for safety. The main car park and drop-off lane to serve the Lower-Prep, Upper-Prep and Senior school and there is a smaller car park to the rear of the grounds for Nursery and Pre-Prep. Exit from the school grounds is via an exit only gate back onto the B3058.
