



Peripatetic Violin Teacher – January 2018

We are seeking an inspiring peripatetic Violin teacher to join our busy Music Department from January 2018 to teach individual lessons to pupils aged between 5-16 years.

- Our peripatetic teachers are self-employed and the current rate of pay is £32 p/h.
- Hours may vary (currently 3 hours per week) depending on pupil numbers and some flexibility is desirable.
- There may be some opportunity for working with school ensembles.

Main responsibilities

- To teach individual 30 minute lessons to pupils from beginner to advanced level.
- To thoroughly prepare pupils for ABRSM and other practical examinations where appropriate.
- To prepare pupils for recitals and performance opportunities within school as appropriate.
- To encourage participation in school and outside ensembles and support the work of the Ballard Music Department.
- To organise timetables in conjunction with the Director of Music.
- To communicate with parents and keep the Director of Music updated on progress.
- To provide written reports (usually once a year) and arrange parental observations.
- To be aware and considerate of individual pupil needs by liaising with the Director of Music and other relevant teaching staff.
