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| 1. Fees are calculated on an annual basis and divided into three equal segments to equate to the three terms in a school year. Includes lunch and personal accident insurance   |

Please note that in order to conform with consumer credit legislation fees are payable in advance and therefore <b>payments commence on 1 June</b> prior to the academic year commencing September. Should you wish to commence a plan during the year it will be necessary to pay a term's fees in advance before a plan can start - please contact the Bursar's office for full details. |
